### WOSU Classroom Leads Statewide Initiative to Increase Students' Digital Wellness

What does it mean to be digitally fit? Our world has been forever changed through technological advancements. Technology is an amazing tool that provides incredible access for kids, but technology access is not without its challenges. How are we preparing our youth for life in the digital world?

Over the past year, WOSU Classroom has worked with thirteen school districts in the development of a digital wellness toolkit to arm our kids with the knowledge and tools needed to lead a healthy and balanced digital life. With a focus on citizenship, etiquette, well-being and safety, the program includes teacher lessons, a guide for creating a digitally fit culture within the schools and school communications.

## Plan to Rescan

Recently, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) held an auction to reallocate TV broadcast airwaves for wireless internet broadband services. At the conclusion of the auction, the FCC determined that nearly 1,000 TV stations must move frequencies to make room for wireless internet carriers. As a result, all four of WOSU Public Media's TV stations (WOSU TV, WOSU Kids, WOSU Plus and WOSU Ohio) will be moving frequencies by mid-March 2020.

### Viewers who watch TV over the air for free with an antenna will be impacted:

They will need to rescan their TV sets to be able to continue watching our channels. Rescanning is when your TV finds all the available channels in your area. No new devices, equipment or services are needed to rescan.

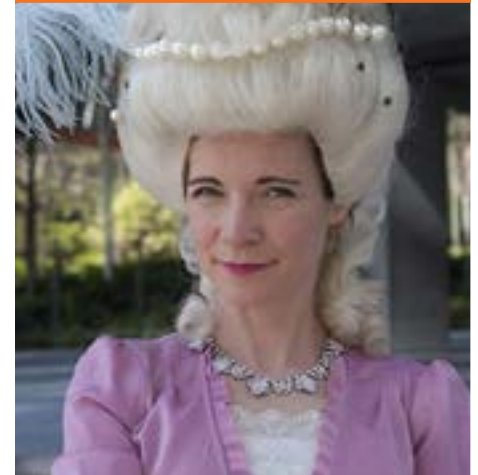

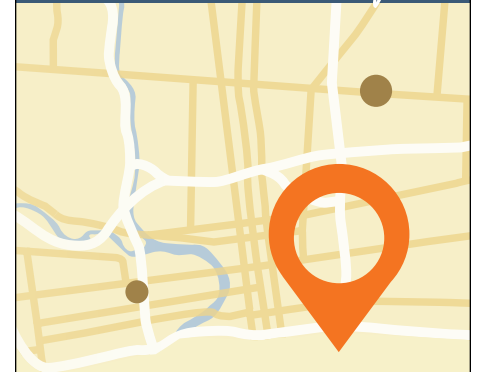

The service is provided to smart TVs, streaming boxes like Roku, computers and smart phones. I was on a train between New York and Washington, D.C. recently, and was able to watch our station on my iPhone via YouTube TV – it seemed a bit magical!

Our digital team is working hard to provide all our TV channels streamed free on our WOSU website and through the WOSU app for Central Ohioans. By the way, the mobile app saw an over 100 percent growth in usage in 2019.

Aside from streaming, we see our members using on-demand offerings from Netflix and Amazon Prime, but also adding WOSU Passport to the mix. With WOSU Passport, you can binge popular PBS programming ahead of the broadcast schedule or catch up on local programming like *Columbus Neighborhoods* and *Broad & High* and special offers like replays of legendary OSU football games.

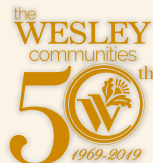
